**Exam Pass Rates:** Five-year average credentialing examination (American Registry of Radiologic Technologists Radiography Exam) pass rate of not less than 75% at first attempt within 6 months of graduation.

**Job Placement:** Five-year average job placement rate of not less than 75% within 12 months of graduation. The JRCERT defines not actively seeking as: Job placement rate is defined as the number of graduates employed in the radiologic sciences compared to the number of graduates actively seeking employment in the radiologic sciences. The JRCERT has defined not actively seeking employment as: 1) graduate fails to communicate with program officials regarding employment status after multiple attempts, 2) graduate is unwilling to seek employment that requires relocation, 3) graduate is unwilling to accept employment due to salary or hours, 4) graduate is on active military duty, and/or 5) graduate is continuing education.
