Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)

The Federal PELL Grant Program is an entitlement program in which a student's eligibility is determined by a standard formula computed by the U.S. Department of Education. Federal PELL Grant Awards are based on family size, income assets, and by actual number of clock hours attended by the student. Any student may apply by obtaining a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) from our school or apply online at: www.fafsa.ed.gov. The ICTC school code is **010053**.

Oklahoma Tuition Aid Grant (OTAG)

The Oklahoma Tuition Aid Grant is administered by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education. The application for OTAG is the same application as the Pell Grant (FAFSA). The information from the FAFSA application is sent to the state you show as legal residence.

Veterans Administration

Veterans education benefits provide a monthly allowance to help eligible veterans or their dependents meet the cost of education and living expenses while training. Please visit the financial aid office for a list of approved programs.

Veterans Vocational Rehabilitation

This program is for individuals who have a physical or mental disability that presents a handicap to employment. Assistance may include tuition, books and supply costs. Workforce Investment Act Programs

These programs provide job training and employment opportunities for economically disadvantaged, unemployed and under employed people. Scholarship Opportunities

INDIAN CAPITAL TECHNOLOGY CENTER FOUNDATION

Tuition scholarship awarded to students who may not qualify for other assistance. Awards are based on need and commitment.

SENIOR SCHOLARSHIP (POLICY FFE)

Any participating school junior, senior or immediate graduate who resides in the Indian Capital district will be eligible for one (1) tuition free program. This tuition free program may be used during their junior and senior year or through the year following their high school graduation. The maximum benefit is a tuition waiver up to 1,050 hours for \$2,100.00 or \$1,050.00 per semester at the in-student rate of \$2.00 per hour for regular full-time career majors. Programs with higher tuition amounts will be capped at above amounts.

SUPERINTENDENT'S SCHOLARSHIP

Applications for the Superintendent's Scholarship are available in the Financial Aid Office located on each campus.

NURSING STUDENT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

This program is for the Practical Nursing student and is administered by Physician Manpower Training Commission. Applications are available in the Financial Aid Office or Practical Nursing Office. www.pmtc.ok.gov/nurses
