SUPERINTENDENT'S ADULT SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

There are times that adult students find themselves in a position of not being eligible for financial assistance. Without assistance, they cannot seek educational training opportunities to improve their standard of living or future growth potential. ICTC is aware of adult students that have unique circumstances which keep those deserving and motivated adults from pursuing training programs. For adults that have unique situations and need financial support, ICTC will offer a special scholarship program for those that do not qualify for financial aid packages or scholarships. The scholarship program is called the "Superintendent's Scholarship Program." One student from each campus will be selected for each school year. Campus Directors will submit all nominees from their campus to the Superintendent (**All Adult Health Occupation students will be considered as a campus of their own**). The Superintendent will then determine the individual adult student who would be awarded a "gap" scholarship for up to one full school year (two semesters).

Eligible Criteria Considerations:

1. Student does not qualify for any other financial assistance
2. Student has not been awarded an ICTC Foundation Scholarship
3. Student has a satisfactory attendance record at the last place of employment or school attended
4. Student has been nominated by the Campus Director
5. Student has a Plan of Study clearly designating a career path
6. Student maintains at least a C average or above
7. Students who have graduated from ICTC in the past will receive special consideration

Applications are due by October 1st.

Students selected for this scholarship program will be funded for up to two consecutive semesters. Should a student receive financial aid from any source after being awarded the Superintendent's Scholarship, the value of the Superintendent's Scholarship shall be equally adjusted to only cover the balance of the tuition and books not covered by other financial aid ("gap" scholarship).

If a campus does not have a candidate for the fall semester or if a previously awarded recipient no longer qualifies in the spring, that campus may submit a request for the spring semester. If there is a spring nominee, that selection would be made no later than January 30th.

All Superintendent Scholarships are limited to only one per campus per school year. Campus Directors will be responsible for communicating with the financial aid division and the awarded student to assure that the student receives the scholarship benefits.

Full GAP Scholarship Covers: Tuition & Books for a Full-Time Program not to exceed two consecutive semesters. The scholarship must be activated within the school year awarded (fall or spring).
